ADVANCING CARE INFORMATION—ACI (Replaces EHR Incentive/Meaningful Use)

Full Participation Requirements for MIPS-Eligible CRNAs:

CRNAs are **NOT** required to participate in ACI due to:

- Lack of access to a certified Electronic Health Record (EHR) system
- Lack of applicable electronic measures

Optional for CRNAs with certified EHR systems **AND** applicable electronic measures:

- Report on at least 4 –5 applicable electronic measures for a minimum of 90 days for base score
- Bonus points available for reporting public health and clinical data registry measures **OR** for using certified EHR technology to complete Improvement Activities

Eligible Clinicians Who Are Hospital Based or Who Qualify for a Hardship Exemption Are Also **NOT** Required to Participate in ACI

Hospital-based clinician: furnishes 75% or more of their professional services in sites identified by Place of Service (POS) codes 21 (inpatient hospital), 22 (outpatient hospital), or 23 (emergency room)

Hardship exemption: includes insufficient Internet connectivity; extreme and uncontrollable circumstance; lack of control over certified EHR technology; or lack of face-to-face encounters

2017 MIPS Advancing Care Information (ACI) Measures

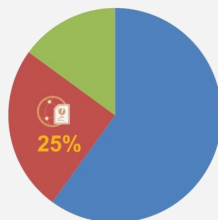
In 2017, there are two measure set options for reporting; the option you use is based on your EHR edition.

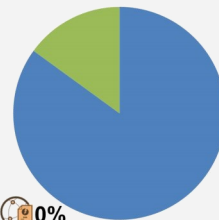
